




## Percentage of high-performing reading teachers is increasing



■ Percentage of Highest and Above Average Performing Reading Teachers




## Percentage of below-average reading teachers decreasing



■ Percentage of Below Average and Lowest Performing Reading Teachers




## Percentage of high-performing math teachers is increasing








## Percentage of below-average math teachers decreasing








# More schools fully staffed at start of school year





■ Percent of Schools Fully Staffed on Opening Day


## Increased retention of Teach for America corps members
