



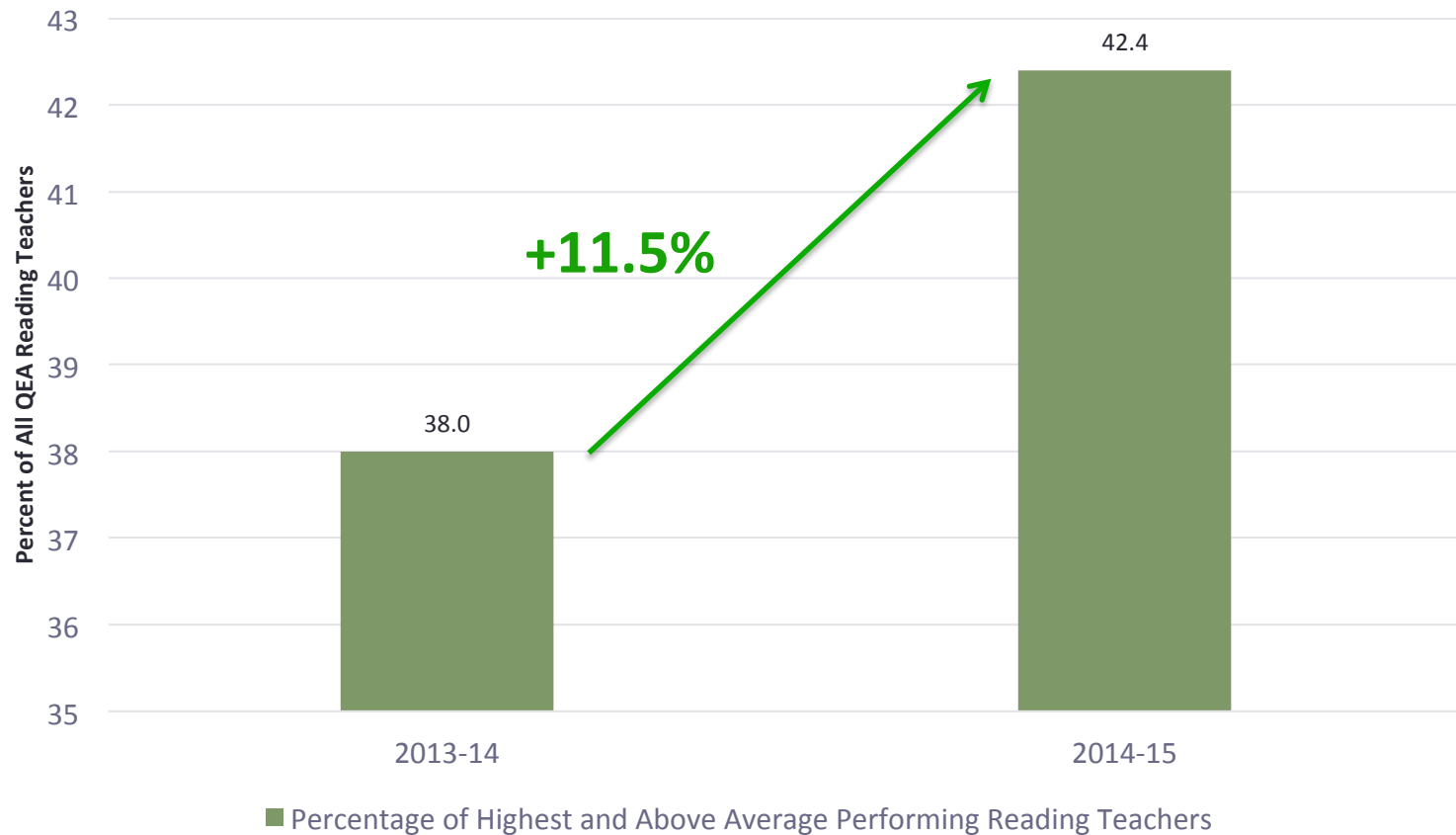

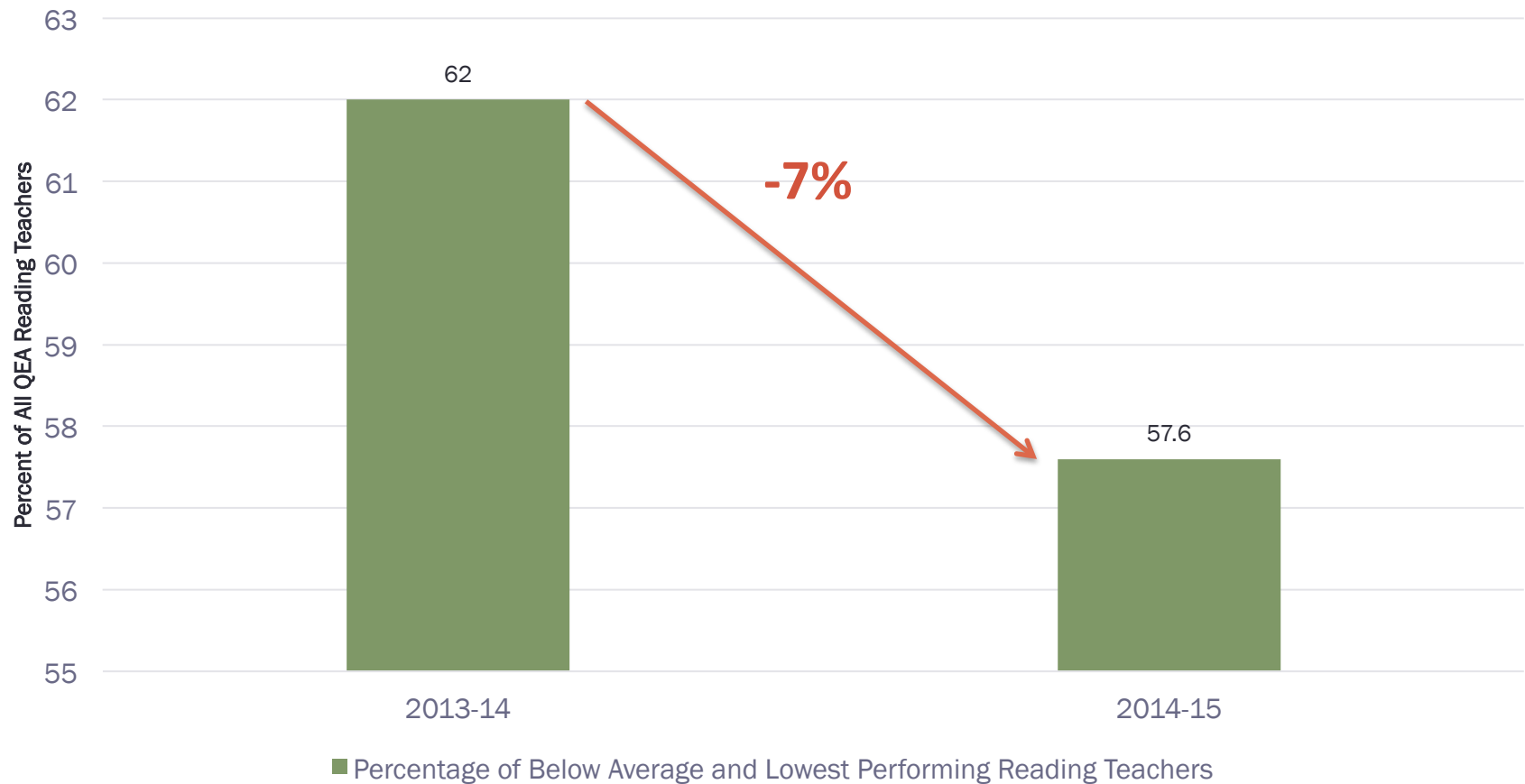

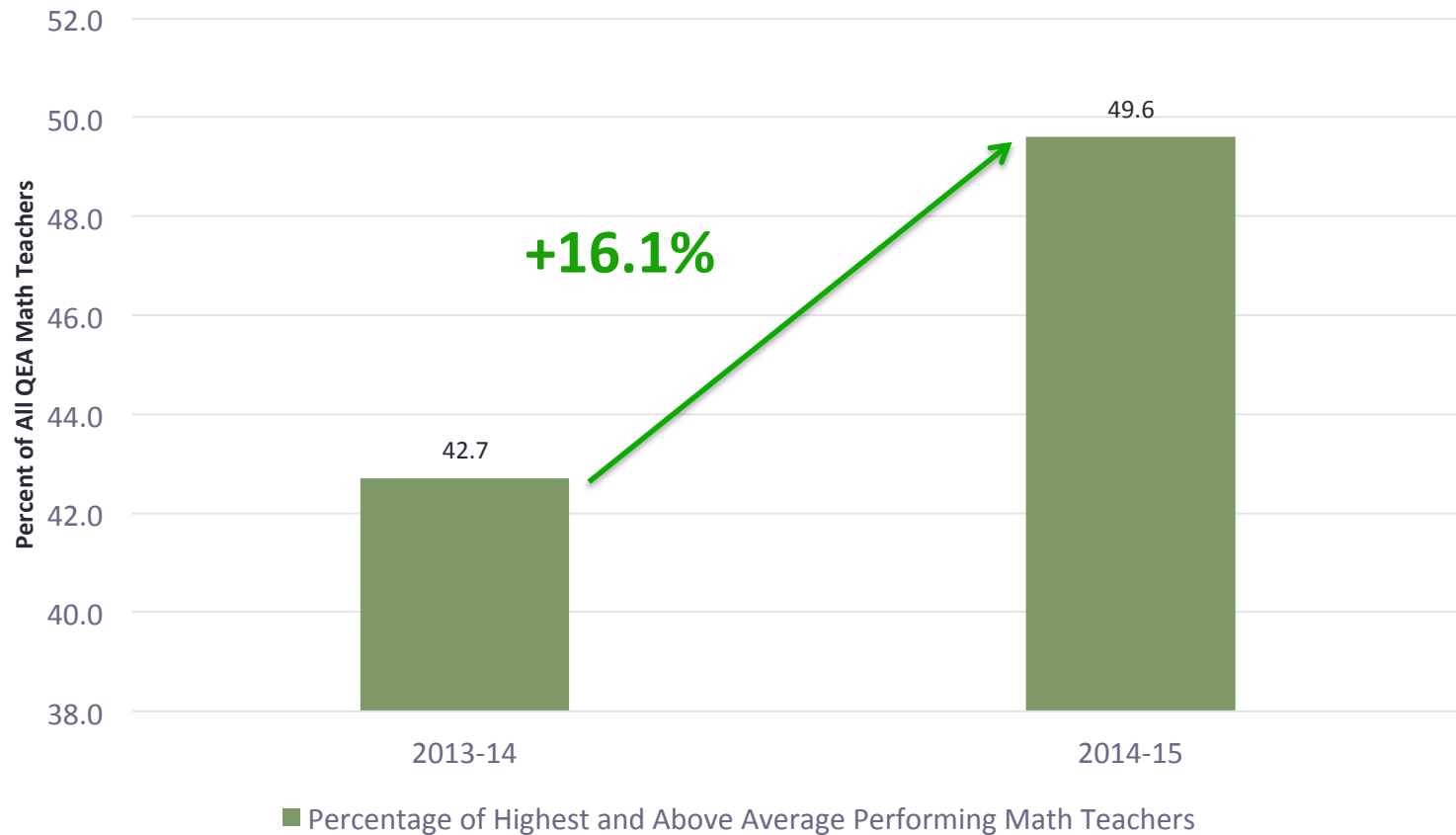
Percentage of high-performing reading teachers is increasing



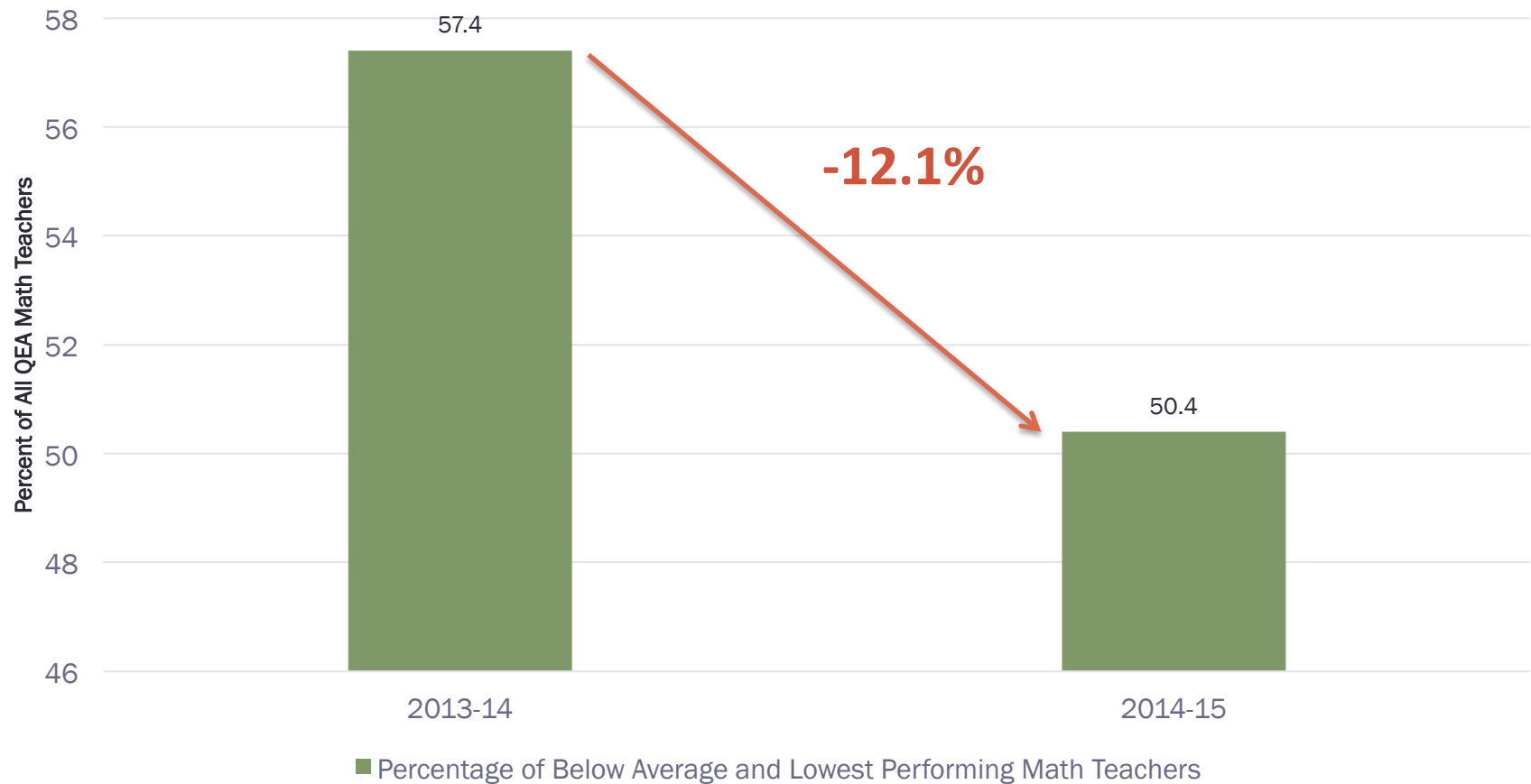
Percentage of below-average reading teachers decreasing

Percentage of below-average math teachers decreasing

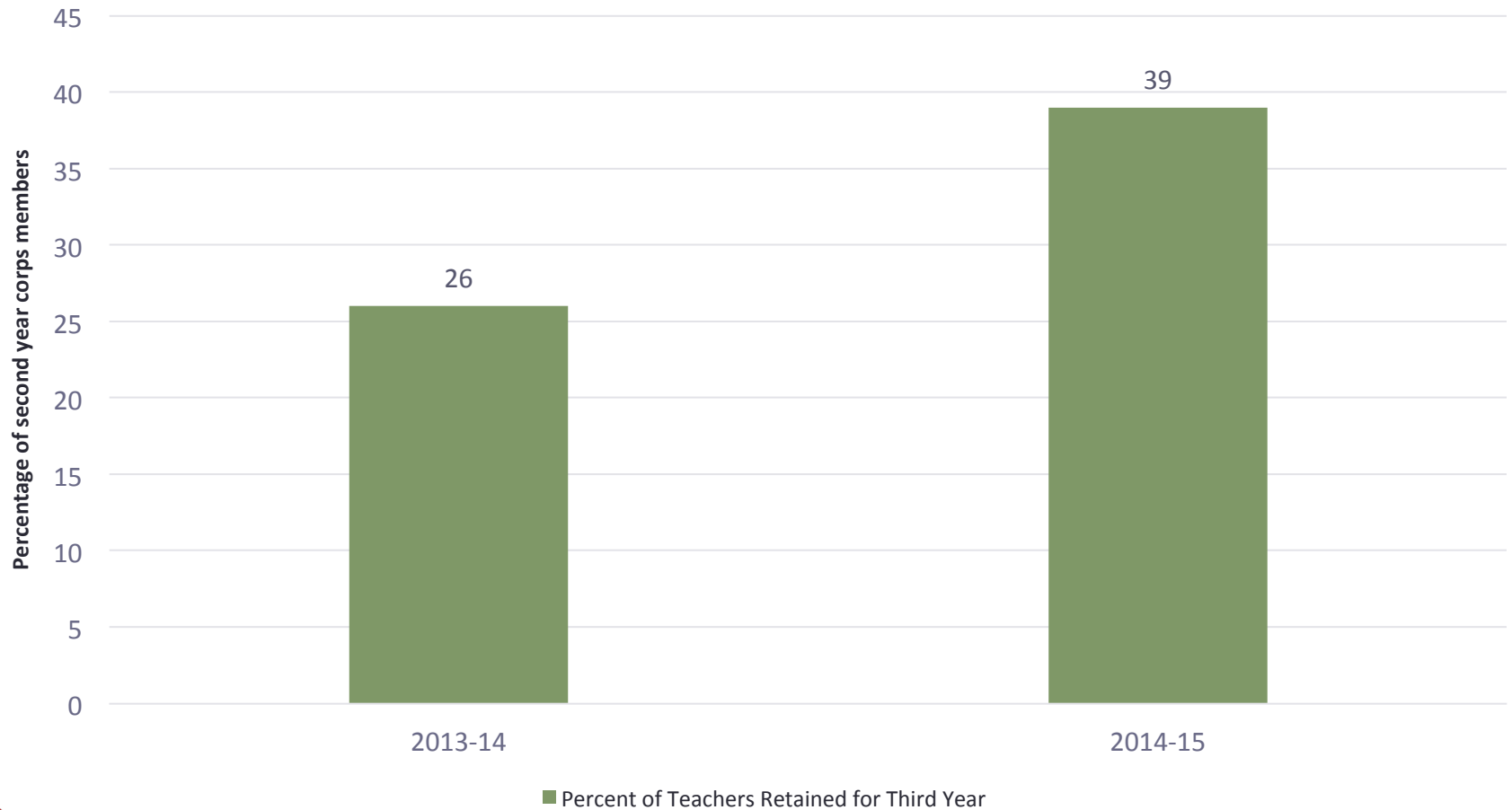


More schools fully staffed at start of school year

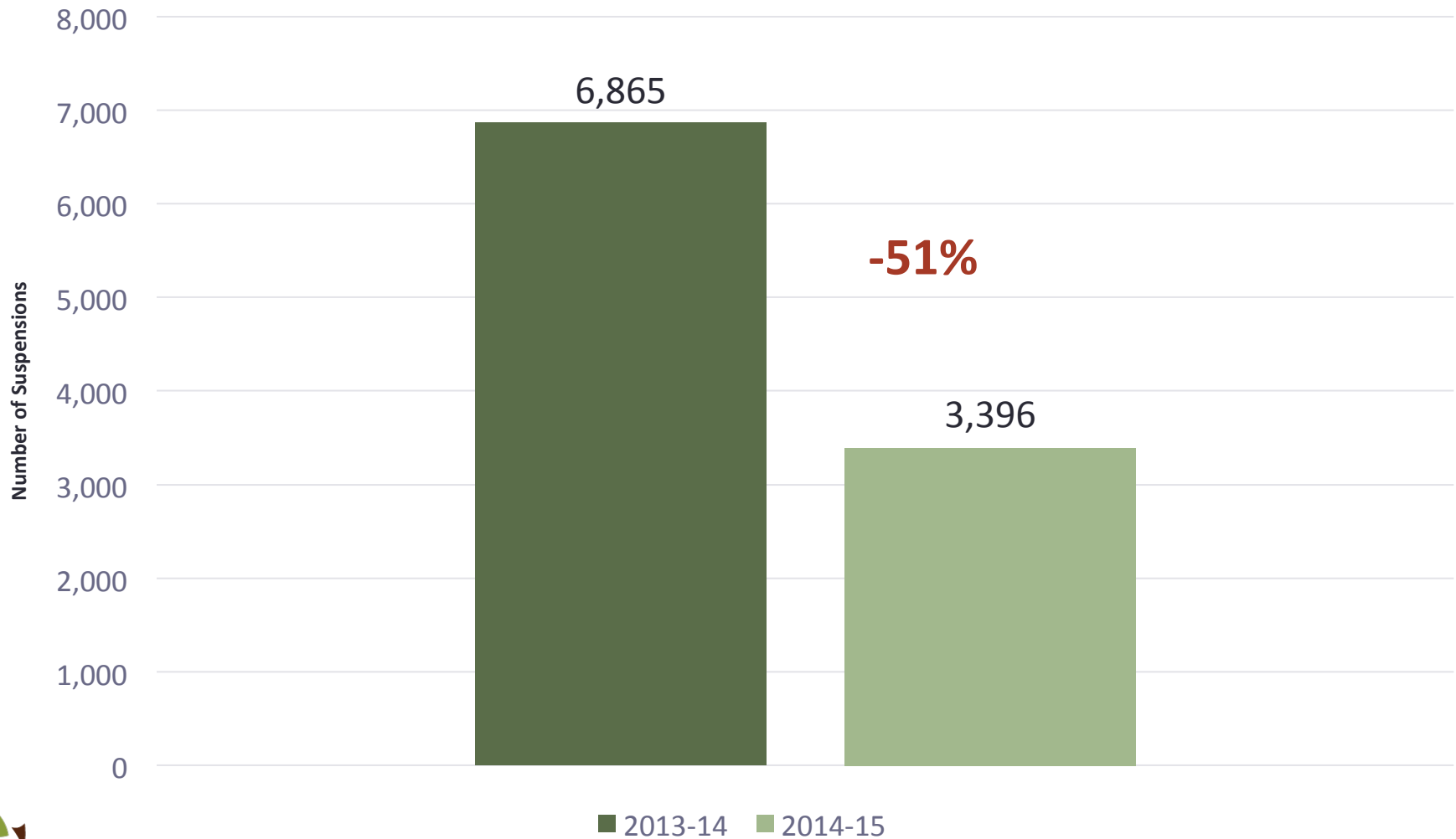
